Navigating an entry

Pronunciation

British and US pronunciation is given using audio and IPA (symbols that show the sound that each letter represents in the word in question). Click on the IPA for an explanation of the symbols. Click on the speaker buttons to hear the word spoken aloud.

Click the speaker symbol next to any Arabic word or phrase to hear pronunciation in Arabic.

Translations

- 3 (in requests)

- 4 (to express permission)

you can park here

Ways of searching

Choose the Arabic-English dictionary in the dropdown panel to search in Arabic. Then you can enter Arabic with your keyboard, or if you don't have access to an Arabic keyboard, you can click on the keyboard icon on the right of the search box, and a clickable Arabic keyboard will fold out.





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If you type in any string of Arabic, you will be presented with the potential entries and a breakdown of the morphology, with links to the relevant entries.

Select the Arabic word you're looking for:

List of Arabic words the string might refer to, most likely at the top

- + وَهَب give away/donate/grant/suppose [PERF] + [VERB]
- + وَهَب and + give away/donate/grant/suppose [IMPER] + you [VERB]
- + وَهَب give away/donate/grant/suppose [MASDAR]
- هَب and + blow/rage/rise (up)/get up/wake up/start/begin [PERF] + [VERB]
- وَهَب CONJ + VERB + PERF + SUBJ:3MS
- + هَب and + blow/rage/rise (up)/get up/wake up/start/begin [MASDAR]

Clicking on any of the options opens that entry

Clicking the + shows the morphological breakdown of the string if pertaining to this entry

cite

Type a phrase. If that phrase is in the dictionary, you will be taken to the entry that it is in, and the relevant section will be highlighted.

It is also possible to type parts of an idiom, and our search functionality will take you to the closest entry.
